SIATech is an award-winning charter high school in partnership with Job Corps, WIOA programs, and school districts, the schools serve low-income, previously out-of-school youth. SIATech individualizes instruction to meet each student's strengths, needs, and goals. The school's safe and caring setting enables students to re-engage, take charge of their learning, and obtain the tools needed to be college-and career-ready. SIATech's family of schools has graduated more than 15,000 previous dropouts since 1998.
